Carolyn, “Lyn” Newell (nee Bishop), of Verona, passed away on Sunday, February 26, 2017. She was 89 years old. Lyn was born in Glen Ridge, NJ to Helen and John B. Bishop on July 20, 1927. She was raised in Montclair, NJ and was married to her devoted husband, Leroy “Roy” B. Newell, Jr. on February 25, 1950. In 1955, they moved their young family to Verona NJ. As a teenager, Lyn professed her faith in Christ. Her faith motivated her to serve God by serving other for the rest of her life. She was known for her faithful guidance, encouragement, counsel, and mentorship. Her energetic personality and genuine love for others enabled her to teach neighborhood Bible Studies in Verona, North Caldwell, Nutley and Bloomfield for over 50 years. She taught the Women’s Bible Class at Brookdale Baptist Church and later served at the Montclair Community Church. She also volunteered with the medical transport for senior citizens in Verona.
