Joseph Daniel Hancock, 87, passed away peacefully at his home at 100, Walnut Street, Bloomfield, New Jersey, USA the morning of March 24, 2016. Born at Crossfield, Pomeroon, Guyana on March 3rd, 1929. Where he attended Primary and Secondary Schools and later post secondary institutions. In 1947 graduated with a Diploma in Education from Bennetts College Of London, England. Joseph was the son of Gilbert James and Mary Emeline Hancock of Guyana.

Joseph began his teaching career whilst studying for his diploma in 1945. He was married to Virginia James and their union produced twelve (12) children. 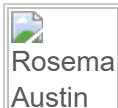

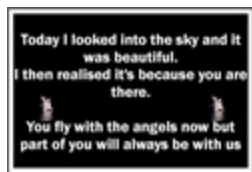
