Patrick Joseph Madden (PJ) age 73, passed away at his home on Saturday, August 14, 2021. A 1966 graduate of Bloomfield High School, he leaves behind a brother Michael Madden and wife Carol Chambers-Madden. PJ was predeceased by his Mother, Jeanne Marie Madden (Gowens) and Robert Madden.

PJ worked at Federal Shoe Store in Bloomfield Center, AMC Auto dealership as their Service Manager, an auto mechanic and, Midlantic Bank as a boilerman. His family owned their own Texaco station in Montclair. Beginning in 1978 they owned Binky's Tavern Belleville, eventually selling in 2014.
